

Western link 2 Briefing.

Diweddariad - Update

Cafodd Cyngor plwyf Clynnog ein briffio gen Dylan Herbert or Grid Cenedlaethol ynglun a prosiect WL2.

Cawsom ein goleuo ar ei ddibenion - strwythyr - amserlen.

-Mae ein defnydd o egni yn cynyddu ac yn symud i ffwrdd o egni ffosil tuag at egni gwyrdd. Mae uwchraddio y grid yn hanfodol ar gyfer addasu ir newid sydd ar y gorwel.

Yn llawn gwybodaeth ir cyhoedd a mae modd rhoi adborth a hysbysiad o unrhyw bryderon sydd ganddoch.

Bydd cyfarfod / ymgynghoriad cyhoeddus yn neuadd Clynnog yn ystod mis Mehefin. Erbyn hynny,bydd opsiynau ynglun a llwybrau posib ir cable, ond fydd dim penderfyniad ynglun a pa lwybyr yn cael ei wneud tan y bydd yr holl adborth gan y cyhoedd ar tiffeddianwyr wedi ei gasglu. Mae y GC yn gobeithio cyflwyno ei cais cynllunio ir prosiect yn haf 2027.

I'r rhai ohonom sy'n pryderu am yr aflonyddwch i fywyd gwyllt a bioamrywiaeth - mae enghreifftiau o brosiectau tebyg lle mae cynefinoedd wedi eu gwarchod ac mewn rhai achosion mewn cyflwr gwell yn dilyn gofal a monitro ar ôl gosod ceblau. Hefyd, po fwyaf o wybodaeth a phryderon y gallwn eu darparu i'r grid mewn perthynas â chynefinoedd penodol, y gorau. Hefyd dylid pwysleisio yr angen i fonitro ar ôl y prosiect.

I'r rhai ohonoch sy'n pryderu am fewnforio pŵer o'r Alban yn hytrach na defnyddio'r potensial cynhyrchu ynni gwyrdd sydd gan Gogledd Cymru i'w gynnig trwy ynni gwynt - llanw a dŵr. Byddai'r uwchraddio hwn yn rhoi sgôp i'r potensial hynu.

Nid ydym yn teimlo bod achos i bryderu am y prosiect hwn ar hyn o bryd ac rydym am alw ar y cyhoedd i beidio gor bryderu.

Byddwn yn eich diweddarau ar union ddyddiad yr ymgynghoriad cyhoeddus.

Clynnog Parish Council were briefed on WL2 by Dylan Herbert from the National Grid. We were briefed on the purposes - structure and timeline.

-Our use of energy is increasing and moving away from fossil energy towards green energy. Upgrading the grid is essential for adapting to the change that is on the horizon.

- The NG has informed land owners councilors and parish councils of the project. The public are advised to visit the WL2 website

to learn more about the project and provide feedback and notifications of any concerns you may have.

There will be a public meeting/ consultation in Clynnog village hall sometime in June. Options regarding possible routes for the cable will be announced then. No decision on which route will be made until all the feedback from the public and landowners has been collected. The NG hopes to submit its planning application for the project in the summer of 2027.

A positive note to our concerns about the disruption to wildlife and bio diversity is the examples of similar projects where habitats have been protected and in some cases in better condition following care and post project monitoring.

It was good to hear also that the cable would not be as large or intrusive as we initially thought (about 6") and that it would be possible to lay the cable under the shoreline by directional drilling rather than trenching. The same would be the case under rivers and other sensitive habitats.

The more information and concerns we can provide the grid in regards to certain habitats the better, and also push for post project monitoring.

For those of you who are concerned about importing power from Scotland rather than making use of the green energy production potential North Wales has to offer through wind - tidal and hydro power. This upgrade would give scope to this potential.

We do not feel that there is case for concern about this project at this stage and we wish to call for the public not to be alarmed or "panic stricken" as was quoted in one article.

We will update you of the exact date of the public consultation.
